What is the Shuttle?

The Shuttle is a mobile interactive unit. Its main objective is to provide the general public and other target audiences with the chance to interact with various road safety campaigns and to spread the message about the importance of road safety. The new Shuttle has been on the road since June 2016.



Using the latest simulations and immersive technologies this experience aims to raise awareness around killer behaviours such as speeding, driver distraction, driver fatigue, driving under the influence of alcohol, and many other issues.

Test your driving skills and reaction time on the car simulators and break reaction timer. Try to avoid distractions in busy city traffic or stay awake on a late night drive in the virtual reality simulators. Cyclists can brush up on rules of the road in a surround screen simulator, whilst the motorcycle simulator offers insight into what the road looks like from a biker's perspective.



The Road Safety Educators are a team of qualified teachers who accompany the shuttle at all events. They will lead the sessions and introduce participants to the experience and learning objectives. They will be on hand throughout the session to discuss all aspects of road safety and address any queries attendees may have.
