Medical Insurance	https://international.ufv.ca/plan-your-stay/medical-insurance/ Inbound students are enrolled in mandatory medical insurance through UFV's preferred provider, Guard.Me. One-semester students: Guard.Me Medical Insurance for the entire duration of exchange (four months). Two-semester students: Guard.Me Medical Insurance coverage for first three months, followed by provincial Medical Services Plan (MSP). Students must enrol in MSP within the first 10 days of your arrival in B.C. if they are an international student and will be studying in B.C. for six or more months. Opt-out: Students can apply to opt-out from Guard.me medical insurance by providing a proof of equivalent coverage.
