<b>Subject areas</b>	For subject specific agreements, students are expected to choose a majority of their courses and credits in the subject area, which is covered by the inter-institutional agreement. Upon request, it might be possible to

<b>Nomination deadline</b>	<p>We are happy to accept nominations as early as January (for the autumn semester) and August (for the spring semester).</p> <p>The general deadline for nominations is the <b>1<sup>st</sup> of April</b> for the autumn semester and <b>1<sup>st</sup> of October</b> for the spring semester. <i>Please note that you might have agreed on other deadlines in your agreement.</i></p> <p><b><i>Please note that a nomination is only considered accepted if you receive a confirmation e-mail from the international coordinator at the University of Gothenburg.</i></b></p>
