German Intensive Language Course	All exchange students are invited to attend an intensive German language course (no application necessary, free of charge).  The course generally takes place during the two weeks before the beginning of semester (Mid-September/ Mid-March; Please plan your arrival in Wiesbaden accordingly).  Course is approx. 20 hours per week / 4 ECTS credits.
	→ Important note: our intensive course is primarily aimed at existing A to B1- levels. Students with a level B2 in German <i>may</i> be asked to choose a semester-long course, if they are interested in taking a German language class

Semester fee	Exchange students pay a reduced semester fee (no administration fee), the semester fee includes a study ticket and liability insurance (approx. EUR 260/semester, compulsory)
Costs of Living Expenses/ month	Approx. EUR 950 (incl. accommodation)
Insurance	Accident and Liability Insurance for enrolled exchange students (costs included in semester administration fee). Students have to prove sufficient health insurance, either by providing a European Health Insurance Card, or contracting insurance with a German health insurance company (non-EU citizens).
International Student Organisation	Buddy Program organized by RheinMain University. Students will get their buddies´ contact details some weeks before the start of the semester. Further information sent after admission.
