


Requirements for Year Abroad (Spanish)

- **Academic Credits at Host University**

You are required to bring back a total of **45 ECTS** from your year abroad: **twenty-five in Spanish** and **twenty in your second subject**.

Your subject requirements for Spanish are: minimum of one Latin American Literature Module; minimum of one Spanish Literature Module; minimum of one Spanish language course; Current Affairs portfolio (Details to be distributed by Spanish Department). The remaining credits for Spanish must come from Filología Hispánica.



- **Documentation – Brochure for Outgoing Erasmus Students**

This includes a grant application form, two copies of the Institution-Student Agreement, Learning Agreement form, a Certificate of Attendance form

Standard documentation required on arrival include a letter of introduction (provided to you by the Spanish Dept. prior to departure) and copies and translations of the following documents: Passport, birth certificate, transcript and letter of introduction (to be provided by the Department at NUIG)

- **Documentation – Learning Agreement**

All students must complete a learning agreement to be signed by both institutions. You will agree your subject choices with your academic co-ordinators (Spanish and Second Subject) in Ireland and then get two signatures at your host institution. The first will be from your **academic co-ordinator** and the second will be from **Relaciones Internacionales**. If this process is not completed you will not be entitled to the second instalment of the Erasmus Grant

- **Documentation – Transcript of Results from Year Abroad**

Your Spanish University will send your academic transcript directly to you. It is your responsibility to submit your transcript to Spanish at NUI Galway in order for your results to be considered for the award of a BA International

You must comply with all of the above requirements in order to qualify for the award of a BA International.
