Sarah co-founded and is a Co-Chair of UPEN. As Director of Programmes, she provides strategic direction and oversees coordination of **UPEN** Programmes work (supported £6m UKRI award). She is a Visiting Professor of Practice at Newcastle University, Vice President (Policy & Partnerships) at Science Association, and Co-Director British а Research on Research Institute CIC. From 2020-24 she led million Capabilities in Academic-Policy Engagement (CAPE) project and from 2023-24 was Principal Investigator of the ESRC-funded International Public Policy Observatory.
