## Learn about oceans and galaxies at big free-entry science celebration in city

DO you know what an exoplanet is? Ever stood inches from some of Europe's largest satellites? Or held a living starfish in your hands? What if the opportunity to do this and much, much more was right on your doorstep?

On Friday, September 23
Ireland will host 'Sea2Sky' - its
first ever European
Researchers Night - in
Leisureland and the
Atlantaquaira, Salthill. This
free one day celebration of science in inner and outer space,
is being organised by NUI Galway in collaboration with the
Marine Institute and Galway
Atlantaquaria.

It will give visitors an opportunity to learn everything they've ever wanted to know about the sea and space in an action-packed day of theatre, art, shows, concerts, debates and exhibitions.

Visitors to the event will have the opportunity to take a 3D tour of the universe and the sea; see local theatre companies performing topical shows throughout the day; sit in on lively discussions in the Café Scientifique; be aweinspired by a fire juggling and drumming show on the beach, and wrap it all up with a rocking live concert at 10pm.

Sea2Sky offers the opportunity for the public to engage with scientists and their research in fun and interactive ways. For one day only these 'ordinary people with unusual occupations' will come into contact with visitors and will present their research work to the general public.

Different exhibits exploring marine science, atmospheric science and astronomy will be set up throughout the Main Hall at Leisureland. A circus tent on the lawn will be the venue for an array of theatrical performances ranging from storytelling to puppets, while a travelling Planetarium will be set up inside to provide an upclose look the galaxies beyond.

Atlantaquaria will provide free access to the Aquarium and all of its exhibits throughout the day and will be running kid-friendly science experiment demonstrations from 3-5pm.
