The University of Antwerp (UAntwerp) has a history dating back to 1852. In October 2003, three universities in Antwerp were brought together to form the university we know today, which explains the UAntwerp scoring highly in several young university rankings. 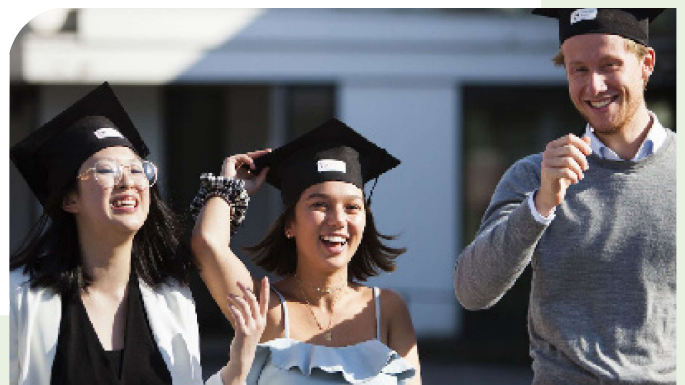
