MMIC (Marketing & Management in an international context) is a curriculum which allows students to gain increased knowledge in :

- ✓ Business & management relevant topics like entrepreneurship and negotiation, the environment of business (European Union, globalisation, regionalisation)
- ✓ Management of various aspects of importance for success (HRM, financial aspects, purchase, sales, logistics)
- ✓ Marketing (international marketing, quantitative tools for marketing)
- ✓ Legal aspects (taxes, individual mobility, rules concerning trade of goods & services)
- ✓ Economics and strategies
- > Students can obtain a degree or collect credits under the ECTS scheme, which then are to be validated by their home university
- > The MMIC curriculum is taught by local and foreign institutes' members and by experts with professional background
- MMIC is based on classes and intensive individual learning
