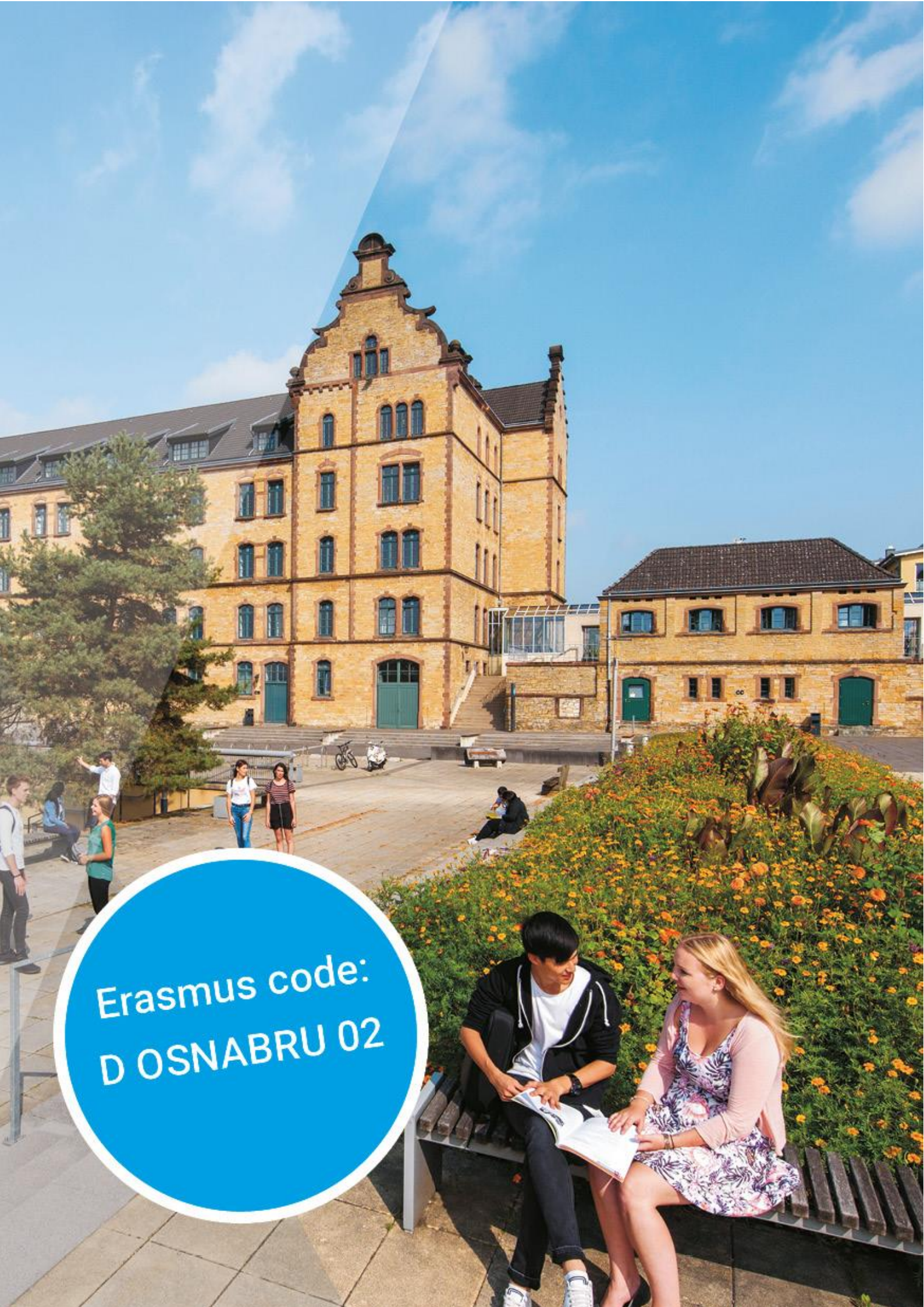

Winter semester

Orientation	2 to 3 days in the week before the classes begin
Lectures	mid-September to mid-January
Examinations	mid-January to beginning of February
Semester break	February
Transcripts	as of March

Summer semester

Orientation	1 to 3 days in the week before the classes begin
Lectures	March to mid-June
Examinations	mid-June to beginning of July
Semester break	July to mid-September
Transcripts	as of September

Latest day of arrival: One day before the mandatory orientation program starts.

Monthly cost of living	Around 800 to 950 euros

EU students: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

Non-EU students: German statutory health insurance. Foreign or private insurances are accepted only if these can be recognized in Germany. This needs to be checked by an Osnabrück insurer.

Student ID cards will be handed out only after a proof of a valid health insurance has been presented and the above-mentioned semester fee has been paid during the enrollment process.
