



## CALL FOR HRB-CRFG FELLOWSHIP APPLICATIONS

The fellowship is undertaken by NUIG MSc in Clinical Research Students in the HRB Clinical Research Facility Galway for a pre-defined period, and working across a variety of disciplines including clinical, data management, Quality and research support.
