Last September the University's Governing Authority, Údarás na hOllscoile, was reconstituted following the passing of new legislation by the Minister for Further & Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science, Simon Harris. The new Governing Authority, whose term runs to January 2025, differs substantially from previous boards in terms of its size (19 members) and composition. Membership includes staff, students and external members who are appointed on the basis of their competencies and who bring significant expertise and a diverse range of experiences.
