STATUTE LXXXIII

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXXXIII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER 1

NEW PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following posts:

Professorship (No. 2) of Biochemistry

Professorship of Modern Irish History (within the Department of History)

Associate Professorship of Pathology (part-time)

Lectureship in Physical Oceanography

Lectureship (No. 2) in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (parttime)

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following Professorships shall be £3,948 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £4,860 by annual increments of £114 for each completed year of service since appointment:

Professorship (No. 2) of Biochemistry

Professorship of Modern Irish History (within the Department of History)

Prl. 1901

The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Statute LIV of University College Galway, and if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service, if any, of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Professorship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.

 The annual stipend of the Associate Professorship of Pathology (part-time) shall be £2,000. The said annual stipend shall be non-incremental.

The holder of the Associate Professorship of Pathology shall carry out his duties under the direction of the Professor of Pathology.

- 4. The holder of each of the foregoing two full-time Professorships and the holder of the part-time Associate Professorship of Pathology shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED that such further continuance in office be recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
- 5. (a) The foregoing two full-time Professorships, and the part-time Associate Professorship of Pathology, shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of each Professorship and of the Associate Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.
 - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 and Section 3 of this Chapter, and subject to the provisions of Chapter I of Statute LXXII of University College, Gaiway.
 - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
- 6. The holder of each of the foregoing two full-time Professorships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII, Statute LV, Statute LXXV and Statute LXXXI of University College, Galway. The holder of the part-time Associate Professorship of Pathology shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of children payable in pursuance to Statute XXXVII and subsequent amendments.

7. The holder of the part-time Associate Professorship of Pathology shall be required to give clinical instruction to the undergraduate and postgraduate students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe subject to review by the Governing Body.

CHAPTER II

- The holders of the following Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows:
 - (a) Lectureship (full-time) in Physical Oceanography—under the direction of the Professor of Oceanography.
 - (b) Lectureship (part-time) in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (No. 2)—under the direction of the Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology.
- 2. (a) The annual stipend of the holder of the full-time Lectureship in Physical Oceanography shall be £2,652 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,732 by annual increments of £108 for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway, if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
 - (b) The annual stipend of the part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (No. 2) shall be £1,092.
- 3. The holder of each of the foregoing two Lectureships shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for reappointment. If reappointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
- 4. (a) The full-time Lectureship in Physical Oceanography shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of the Lectureship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and of the Statutes of the College.

- (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
- (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
- 5. (a) The holder of the full-time Lectureship in Physical Oceanography shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII, University College, Galway and subsequent amendments.
 - (b) The holder of the part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of children payable in pursuance to Statute XXXVII, University College, Galway, and subsequent amendments.
- 6. The holder of the part-time Lectureship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall be required to give clinical instruction to the undergraduate and postgraduate students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe subject to review by the Governing Body.

CHAPTER III

- Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
- 2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Fifth day of May, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy One and may be cited as Statute LXXXIII University College, Galway, or Stat. LXXXIII Univ. Coll., Galway.
