STATUTE CCXVII

We, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this twenty-second day of November, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-one.

SCHEDULE-STATUTE CCXVII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

1. The Associate Professorship of Obstetrics and Gynaecology shall henceforth be known as the Associate Professorship of Geography.
2. The annual stipend attaching to the foregoing fulltime Associate Professorship shall be the same as that attaching from time to time to the fulltime Associate Professorships of the College.
3. The holder of the foregoing Associate Professorship of Geography shall carry out his duties under the direction of the Professor of Geography.
4. The foregoing Associate Professorship shall be a pensionable office in accordance with the provisions of Statutes CLXI, CLXV, CLXXXVI, CLXXXVII and CCVII, University College, Galway.
5. The holder of the said Associate Professorship shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years :
PROVIDED that such further continuance in office be recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and be sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
6. On the occurrence of a vacancy in the Lectureship (No. 3) in Geography, the said Lectureship shall thereupon be abolished.

CHAPTER II

1. The Lectureship in Applied Physiology shall henceforth be known as the Lectureship (No. 2) in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.
2. The annual stipend attaching to the foregoing Lectureship shall be £2,539.
3. The holder of the said Lectureship shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology.
4. The holder of the said Lectureship shall give clinical instruction to the students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe, subject to review by the Governing Body.
5. The said Lectureship shall be a pensionable office in accordance with the provisions of Statutes CLXI, CLXV, CLXXXVI, CLXXXVII and CCVII, University College, Galway.
6. The holder of the said Lectureship shall, in accordance with the provisions of Statute CXCIV, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his/her duties and to having served a probationary period of two years in the said office to the satisfaction of the Governing Body of the College and of the Senate of the University, continue in office until (s)he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years, **PROVIDED** that such further continuance in office be recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and be sanctioned annually by the said Senate.

CHAPTER III

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of November, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-one, and may be cited as Statute CCXVII, University College, Galway, or Stat. CCXVII, Univ. Coll., Galway.
