

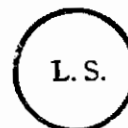

**STATUTE CI**

We, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

**SCHEDULE—STATUTE CI**

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions, and modifications hereinafter set forth.

**CHAPTER I**

**STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO STATUTORY  
OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS FROM  
1ST JUNE, 1974, UNTIL 30TH NOVEMBER, 1974**

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends and allowances attached to the Offices, Professorships and Lectureships referred to in Table A, Table B and Table C to this Chapter shall, on and from the first day of June, 1974, be the stipends and allowances set forth in the said tables.
2. This Chapter shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st day of May, 1974.

**TABLE A:**

1. The annual stipend of the President shall be £10,266. In addition, he shall be entitled to residence, fuel and light as heretofore valued for pension purposes at £1,479, per annum, and to a non-pensionable allowance of £1,479 in respect of the expenses of his office.

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time offices namely:
- The office of Secretary-Bursar,
  - The office of Academic Secretary,
  - The office of Librarian,
- shall be £5,601 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £6,738 in accordance with Table B of this Chapter, subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.
3. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Professorship shall be £5,601 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £6,738 in accordance with Table B of this Chapter, subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.
4. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Associate Professorship shall be £5,935.
5. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Lectureship shall be £4,080 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £5,529 in accordance with Table B of this Chapter subject to the provisions, where applicable, of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

## CHAPTER II

## STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO STATUTORY OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS AS FROM 1st DECEMBER, 1974

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Chapter I of this Statute or in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends and allowances attached to the Offices, Professorships and Lectureships referred to in Table A, Table B and Table C to this Chapter shall, on and from the first day of December, 1974 be the stipends and allowances set forth in the said tables subject to the provision set forth in Chapter VI of this Schedule.
2. This Chapter shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th day of November, 1974.

TABLE A:

1. The annual stipend of the President shall be £10,824. In addition, he shall be entitled to residence, fuel and light as heretofore valued for pension purposes at £1,554 per annum, and to a non-pensionable allowance of £1,554 in respect of the expenses of his office.
2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time offices, namely:
  - (a) The office of Secretary-Bursar,
  - (b) The office of Academic Secretary,
  - (c) The office of Librarian,
 shall be £5,927 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £7,120 in accordance with Table B of this Chapter, subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.
3. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Professorship shall be £5,927 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £7,120 in accordance with Table B of this Chapter, subject to the provisions where applicable of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.
4. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Associate Professorship shall be £6,277.
5. The annual stipend of the holder of each full-time Lectureship shall be £4,331 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £5,850 in accordance with Table B of this Chapter, subject to the provisions, where applicable, of Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway.

## CHAPTER III

## PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES

1. For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the President, the annual stipend deemed to be payable at date of retirement or at date of death shall be £11,745 as and from the first day of June, 1974 and, subject to the provision of Chapter IV of this Statute, as and from the first day of December, 1974, £12,378 subject to the provision of Chapter IV of this Statute.

For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the Lady Superintendent, the annual stipend payable to her at date of retirement or at date of death, shall

be (deemed to be) £4,663 as and from the 1st day of June, 1974 and £4,942 as and from the first day of December, 1974, subject to the provision of Chapter IV of this Statute.

2. Instead of the sum now being paid annually into the Statutory Pensionable Officers' Pension Fund, there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the said fund out of the annual Income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other monies of the College applicable thereto such sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing Pensions and Gratuities.

#### CHAPTER IV

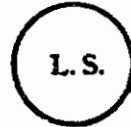
#### STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO STATUTORY OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS FROM 1ST MARCH, 1975

1. If during the period mid-November, 1973 to mid-November, 1974, the Consumer Price Index rises by more than 10 per cent, the stipends and allowances attaching to all the foregoing offices shall be increased by one per cent for each one per cent rise in the Index over that 10 per cent. The aforementioned increases, if such there be, shall be payable as and from 1st March, 1975.

#### CHAPTER V

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of April, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-five and may be cited as Statute CI of University College, Galway, or Stat. CI Univ. Coll., Galway.
