STATUTE CLXXXI

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE — STATUTE CLXXXI

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

- 1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the stipends attached to the Offices of President, Secretary-Bursar, Academic Secretary, Librarian, fulltime Professorships, fulltime Associate Professorships, Associate Secretaryships and fulltime Lectureships shall as from the 1st day of January, 1985 be increased by 3%.
- 2. As from the 1st day of July, 1985, the stipends attached to the Offices mentioned in Section 1 of this Chapter shall be increased by 3%.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College, the annual stipend attached to each part-time Professorship and each part-time Lectureship shall as from the 1st day of January, 1985 and as from the 1st day of July, 1985, respectively, be increased as set out in respect to each post in

Table A to this Chapter.

4. The Governing Body shall have power to round to the nearest pound the amounts of all stipends in which an increase is provided in this Statute.

CHAPTER II

1. For the purpose of calculating the pension and gratuity respectively payable on the retirement and on the death or retirement of the President, the annual stipend deemed to be payable at date of retirement or at date of death shall be £37,003 as from the 1st day of January, 1985, and £38,113 as from the 1st day of July, 1985.

CHAPTER III

 The Associate Professorship of Pathology (part-time) and the part-time Associate Professorship of Medicine are hereby abolished.

CHAPTER IV

- Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
- 2. This Statute shall come into operation on the sixth day of December, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-five and may be cited as Statute CLXXXI, University College Galway, or Stat. CLXXXI, Univ. Coll. Galway.
