STATUTE LIV

WE, the Governing Body of University College Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this Sixth day of November, 1963.

SCHEDULE STATUTE LIV

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, modifications and additions hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

THE LECTURESHIP IN PATHOLOGY AND THE LECTURESHIP IN BACTERIOLOGY

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Statute LIII of University College, Galway, or any previous Statute of the College the stipend of the holder of the Lectureship in Pathology and the stipend of the holder of the Lectureship in Bacteriology shall be £700 each per annum on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £790 each per annum by annual increments of £30 for each completed year of service thereafter.

CHAPTER II

STIPEND OF NEWLY APPOINTED FULL-TIME PROFESSORS AND LECTURERS

1. Whenever a full-time Professor or full-time Lecturer shall be hereafter appointed the Governing Body may in its discretion and if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service of any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Professorship or Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto. The stipend payable whenever increments are added pursuant to this Statute shall be decided at the first ordinary meeting of the Governing Body to be held subsequent to the date of appointment.

2. Chapter III of Statute XLII of University College, Galway, is hereby revoked, and the provisions as to reckoning years of service set forth in Section 4 and Section 5 of Table 'A' to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway shall henceforth cease to apply.

CHAPTER III

THE ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP OF ANCIENT CLASSICS

1. There shall be in the College (on such Professorship being instituted within the College by the Senate of the National University of Ireland) a second full-time Professorship of Ancient Classics to be known as The Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics.

2. The annual stipend of the Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics shall be £2,100. The annual stipend shall be non-incremental.

3. The holder of the Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics shall carry out his duties subject to the direction of the Professor of Ancient Classics and shall deliver lectures and instruction through Irish and through English in such manner that the Professor of Ancient Classics, the Associate Professor of Ancient Classics and any Lecturers and Assistants in Ancient Classics may in cooperation between them provide a complete course through the medium of Irish and a complete course through the medium of English.

4. The duties of the Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics as regards amount and allocation of work may be hereafter more fully defined by regulations of the Governing Body.

5. Every Lecturer and every Assistant in Ancient Classics shall carry out his duties under the sole direction of the Professor of Ancient Classics.

6. The Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics shall be a pensionable office within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate table of the Pension Scheme. Pension and gratuity shall be calculated and paid to the holder in accordance with the provisions of Chapters I and II of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statute of the College. There shall be paid into the Pension Fund an additional sum as an Actuary shall certify for provision for pension and gratuity as aforesaid. The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating pension and gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be £2,100.

7. The holder of the Associate Professorship of Ancient Classics shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children payable pursuant to Section 6 of Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER IV

THE WIDOWS OF STATUTORY PENSIONABLE OFFICERS
PENSION FUND

1. Chapter II of Statute XL of University College, Galway is hereby amended as follows :-

- (a) By the substitution in Section 1 of the words "for life" for the words "until the expiration of fifteen years" mentioned therein.
- (b) By the substitution in Section 2 of the words "for life" for the words "until the expiration of six years" mentioned therein.
- (c) By the substitution in Section 3 of the figure "£425" for the figure "£250" mentioned therein.

2. Chapter III of Statute XL of University College, Galway is hereby amended as follows :-

- (a) By the substitution of the figure "£200" for the figure "£100" wherever mentioned in the said Chapter.
- (b) By the substitution of the words "for life" for the words "until the expiration of six years" in the said Chapter.

3. In addition to the sum provided for by Section III of Chapter II of Statute XL of University College, Galway, there shall be henceforth paid into "The Widows of Statutory Pensionable Officers Pension Fund" by the Office-holders or Pensioners as the case may be (except by a Statutory Pensionable Officer who had retired prior to the 19th October, 1953 being the date of coming into operation of Statute XL of University College, Galway) an additional contribution amounting to 25% of an existing contribution. Such additional contribution shall be due and payable together with and on the same date as the sums for which each of such persons is or shall be liable as a condition of participation in the Scheme for payment to Widows.

CHAPTER V

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Sixth day of November, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-three and may be cited as Statute LIV of University College, Galway, or Stat. LIV, Univ. Coll., Galway.
