STATUTE LVIII

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the seal of University College, Galway make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LVIII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP OF HISTORY AND
LECTURESHIP (No. 2) IN CHEMISTRY

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland one full-time pensionable Professorship and one full-time pensionable Lectureship under the titles following :—
 - (i) The Associate Professorship of History.
 - (ii) The Lectureship (No. 2) in Chemistry.
2. The annual stipend of the Associate Professorship of History shall be £2,800. The annual stipend shall be non-incremental.
3. The annual stipend of the Lectureship (No. 2) in Chemistry shall be £1,700 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,400 by annual increments of £70 for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Statute LIV of University College, Galway and if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.

4. The holder of the Lectureship (No. 2) in Chemistry shall subject to good conduct and to the fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If re-appointed he shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years : *Provided* that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
5. The holder of the Associate Professorship of History shall deliver lectures and instruction through the medium of the Irish language. The duties of the Associate Professorship of History as regards amount and allocation of work may be hereafter more fully defined by regulations of the Governing Body.
6. The Lecturer (No. 2) in Chemistry shall carry out his duties under the sole direction of the Professor of Chemistry.
7. (a) The Associate Professorship of History, and the Lectureship (No. 2) in Chemistry shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway and amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate table of the Pension Scheme. The holder shall in each case be entitled to payment of pension and gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statutes of the College.
(b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder.
(c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sums as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
8. The holder of the Associate Professorship of History and the holder of the Lectureship (No. 2) in Chemistry shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children payable pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER II

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute will come into operation on the Fifteenth day of December, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four, and may be cited as Statute LVIII, University College, Galway, or Stat. LVIII, Univ. Coll., Galway.
