STATUTE LXIX

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, DO by this present instrument under the seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXIX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

NEW PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS

1 There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland the following posts:—

- Professorship of Geography
- Associate Professorship of Spanish.
- Professorship of Political Science and Sociology.
- Professorship of Psychology.
- Lectureship (No. 2) in History.
- Lectureship in German.
- Lectureship in English (with special reference to Anglo-Irish Literature).
- Lectureship (No. 3) in Modern Irish.
- Lectureship (No. 2) in Education.
- Lectureship in Economic Theory.
- Lectureship (No. 2) in Botany.
- Lectureship (No. 2) in Zoology.
- Lectureship in Mathematical Physics (with special reference to Computational Techniques).
- Lectureship (No. 3) in Chemistry.
- Lectureship (No. 4) in Civil Engineering.
- Lectureship (No. 3) in Mathematics.
- Lectureship in Engineering (with special reference to Industrial Engineering).
- Lectureship (No. 3) in Experimental Physics.

Lecturoships (2) in Medicine (Part-time).
 Lectureship in Medical Biochemistry (Part-time).
 Lectureship in Experimental Medicine (Part-time).
 Lectureship in Anaesthetics (Part-time).
 Lecturoships (2) in Surgery (Part-time).
 Lectureship in Cardiology (Part-time).

2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following three Professorships, (i) Professorship of Geography, (ii) Professorship of Political Science and Sociology, (iii) Professorship of Psychology, shall be £2,990 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £3,680 by annual increments of £69 for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Statute LIV of University College, Galway, and if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Professorship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
3. The annual stipend of the Associate Professorship of Spanish shall be £3,220. The said annual stipend shall be non incremental.
4. The holder of each of the foregoing three Professorships and of the Associate Professorship shall, subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties, continue in office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years, and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
5. (a) The foregoing three Professorships and the Associate Professorship shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of each Professorship and of the Associate Professorship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, and the Statutes of the College.
 - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Statutes of the College shall be deemed to be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 and of Section 3 of this Chapter.
 - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
6. The holder of each of the foregoing three Professorships and of the Associate Professorship shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER II

The holders of the following full-time Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows:—

- a) Lectureship (No. 2) in History—under the direction of the Professor of History and of the Associate Professor of History (through Irish).
 - b) Lectureship in German—under the direction of the Professor of German.
 - c) Lectureship in English (with special reference to Anglo-Irish Literature) under the direction of the Professor of Modern English.
 - d) Lectureship (No. 3) in Modern Irish under the direction of the Professor of Modern Irish
 - e) Lectureship (No. 2) in Education—under the direction of the Professor of Education.
 - f) Lectureship in Economic Theory under the direction of the Professor of Economics, Commerce, and Accounting.
 - g) Lectureship (No. 2) in Botany—under the direction of the Professor of Botany.
 - h) Lectureship (No. 2) in Zoology—under the direction of the Professor of Zoology.
 - i) Lectureship in Mathematical Physics (with special reference to Computational Techniques)—under the direction of the Professor of Mathematical Physics.
 - j) Lectureship (No. 3) in Chemistry—under the direction of the Professor of Chemistry.
 - k) Lectureship (No. 4) in Civil Engineering—under the direction of the Professor of Civil Engineering.
 - l) Lectureship (No. 3) in Mathematics—under the direction of the Professor of Mathematics.
 - m) Lectureship in Engineering (with special reference to Industrial Engineering)—under the direction of the Professor of Civil Engineering.
 - n) Lectureship (No. 3) in Experimental Physics—under the direction of the Professor of Experimental Physics.
2. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the foregoing fourteen full-time Lectureships shall be £1,955 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,760 by annual increments of £80 10s. 0d. for each completed year of service since appointment. The Governing Body may in its discretion in accordance with Chapter II of Statute LIV of University College, Galway if the President (having regard to the qualifications and College service if any of the person appointed) so recommends fix the commencing stipend of the Lectureship at any point in the incremental salary scale applicable thereto.
 3. The holder of each of the foregoing fourteen Lectureships shall be subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If reappointed he shall be subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED

that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.

4. (a) The foregoing fourteen Lectureships shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pension Scheme. The holder of each Lectureship shall be entitled to payment of both Pension and Gratuity under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II and Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statutes of the College.
 - (b) The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall be that payable at date of retirement or death of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of this Chapter.
 - (c) There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid.
5. The holder of each of the foregoing fourteen Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children pursuant to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER III

1. The annual stipend of the following Part-time non-Pensionable Lectureships shall be the sum set opposite the respective Titles of the said Lectureships as follows:—

Lectureships (2) in Medicine	£800 each
Lectureship in Medical Biochemistry	£1,260
Lectureship in Experimental Medicine	£1,260
Lectureship in Anaesthetics	£800
Lectureships (2) in Surgery	£800 each
Lectureship in Cardiology	£600

2. The Holders of the following part-time Lectureships shall carry out the duties of the Lectureships as follows:—

Lectureships (2) in Medicine—under the direction of the Professor of Medicine.

Lectureship in Medical Biochemistry—under the direction of Professor of Biochemistry.

Lectureship in Experimental Medicine—under the direction of the Professor of Experimental Medicine.

Lectureship in Anaesthetics—under the direction of the Professor of Surgery.

Lectureships (2) in Surgery—under the direction of the Professor of Surgery.

Lectureship in Cardiology—under the direction of the Professor of Medicine.

- 3 The holder of the each of the foregoing six Part-time Lectureships shall subject to good conduct and to the due fulfilment of his duties hold office for seven years after which he shall be eligible for re-appointment. If reappointed he shall subject to good conduct and the due fulfilment of his duties hold office until he shall have attained the age of sixty-five years and may thereafter be continued in office for five further years: PROVIDED that such further continuance in office is recommended to the Senate of the National University of Ireland by the Governing Body with the approval of the President and is sanctioned annually by the said Senate.
- 4 The holder of each of the foregoing six Part-time Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of a wife and children payable in pursuance to Statute XXXVII and Statute LV of University College, Galway.
- 5 The holders of the following Lectureships, (1) Lectureships (2) in Medicine, (ii) Lectureship in Experimental Medicine, (iii) Lectureship in Anaesthetics, (iv) Lectureships (2) in Surgery, (v) Lectureship in Cardiology, shall be required to give clinical instruction to the Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of the College at such hours and in such hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe subject to review by the Governing Body

CHAPTER IV

- 1 Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
- 2 This Statute shall come into operation on the Thirty first day of May, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-seven, and may be cited as Statute LXIX University College, Galway, or Stat. LXIX Univ. Coll., Galway.
