STATUTE LXVIII

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the power in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXVIII

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions, and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

PROFESSORSHIP OF GEOLOGY

1. The Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy shall be henceforward known as the Professorship of Geology.

CHAPTER II

ELECTION BY THE GRADUATES OF MEMBERS OF THE  
GOVERNING BODY

Notwithstanding anything contained in Statute XVII, Ch. VI., Statute XXI, and Statute XXXV, University College, Galway or in any other Statute of the College, the following provisions shall henceforth apply for the purpose of the Election by the Graduates of the Members of the Governing Body whom the Graduates are entitled to elect.

1. (a) The Notice required by Statute XVII, Ch. VI, Section 1, to be given to each Graduate of the University whose name appears in the College Register of Graduates shall be given at least three months before the expiration of the period of office of the Governing Body then in being by advertisement in such manner and in such newspapers and/or periodicals as the Governing Body may from time to time determine, and Statute XVII, Ch. VI., Sec. 1, is hereby amended accordingly.

(b) Such Notice shall state the date of the Election Meeting, the latest date for Nomination, and that changes of address in the Register of Graduate Members must be notified to the Registrar on or before the latest date for nomination, and that no change of address will be made during the period between the latest date for Nomination and the date of the Election Meeting, and Statute XXXV is hereby amended accordingly.

2. Statute XVII, Ch. VI as amended is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say :

(a) By the substitution (in the case of Election of Graduates only) in Section 14 of the words "at least twenty-eight days" for the words "at least twenty-one days".

(b) By the insertion in Section 49 after the words "amongst the elected members" where they occur in that Section of the words "other than the members elected by the Graduates of the University who are members of the College".

(c) By the addition of the following Section after Section 50, namely :

50A Whenever a casual vacancy shall occur amongst the members of the Governing Body elected by the Graduates of the University who are members of the College, the Secretary shall report the occurrence of the vacancy to the Governing Body at its next meeting and on being so directed by the Governing Body shall give notice of the occurrence of the vacancy to the Graduates of the University whose names appear on the College Register of Graduates by advertisement in such manner and in such newspapers and/or periodicals as the Governing Body may from time to time determine. The President or his Deputy or the Acting-President, as the case may be, shall thereupon appoint a day for the Meeting of such Graduates for the purpose of electing to fill the vacancy which said day shall be not less than two or more than three months after the date of the advertisement referred to in Section 1 of this Chapter or after the latest of such advertisements, if more than one.

PROVIDED, that the day so appointed shall not be in the months of July, August, or September; and if the day which would have been appointed for such Meeting under this Section but for this proviso, would have fallen in any of these three months, the day to be appointed for the Meeting shall be some day in the month of October next ensuing.

CHAPTER III  
THE SECRETARY

1. The office of Bursar shall henceforth be combined with the office of Secretary, and the present Holder of the Bursarship shall henceforth, without any extra remuneration or emolument, be also the Secretary of the College and shall be known as the Secretary-Bursar of the College.
2. In addition to discharging the duties prescribed by Chapter XXI of Statute XVII of University College, Galway and also the duties prescribed by paragraph 4, of Chapter 1, of Statute LXIII of University College, Galway, the Secretary-Bursar shall discharge the duties which are prescribed for the Secretary by Chapter XX "A" of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and shall do and perform all other acts and duties in relation to the College as by the Statutes and Regulations or decisions of the Governing Body he may be required to do and perform.

CHAPTER IV

1. This Statute shall come into operation on the Thirty-first day of May, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty Seven and may be cited as Statute LXVIII University College, Galway or Stat. LXVIII Univ. Coll., Galway.
