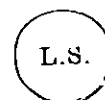
UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, GALWAY.

STATUTE LXXX

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts DO by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

Given under the Common Seal of University College, Galway, this Twenty-fifth day of November, 1969.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE LXXX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

“NEW PENSION”

1. The limitation imposed by subsection (ii) of Section 5 of Statute LI Chapter I is hereby revoked.

CHAPTER II

TRANSFERABILITY OF PENSIONS

1. The College having by Order dated 23 September 1969, of the Minister for Finance been designated an approved organisation under the Superannuation and Pensions Act, 1963, the Governing Body may in respect of the holder of a pensionable position in the College who is, without break of service, transferred or appointed to an established pensionable post in the Civil Service, the Local Authority Service or in the service of another approved organisation, provided that the Minister for Finance and the

authority controlling the approved organisation agree at the time of the transfer or appointment, make such contribution as may be agreed upon in respect of the pensionable service of that person in University College Galway to such other service or organisation. No such payment shall be made by the College in respect of any person who has not completed three years pensionable service in the College and in reckoning the amount to be paid no account shall be taken of years added as set out in Section 9 of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of the College; neither shall the College be required to make any payment in respect of the entitlement of the widow or children of such participant to a widow's pension or children's allowances.

2. In the event of the appointment to a full-time professorship, lectureship or other pensionable post in the College of a person who at the time of his appointment is a member of the Federated Superannuation System for Universities or any similar superannuation scheme, the Governing Body may, in its absolute discretion, agree to pay annually a sum not exceeding fifteen percent of the annual salary of such appointee to continue part of or all existing benefits where practicable or provide alternative benefits with such insurance company as may be agreed with the appointee and likewise provide additional benefits in respect of salary increases.

Provided that in the event of the Governing Body making the payment above referred to such appointee shall not be entitled to participate in any Pension Scheme of the College nor shall he have any rights whatsoever thereunder.

CHAPTER III

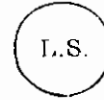
PENSIONS OF HOLDERS OF CONSECUTIVE PENSIONABLE POSITIONS

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 5 of Chapter II of Statute XXXVI and subject to the provisions of Statute LXXII the pensions of those who have held consecutive pensionable positions in the College shall from the date of coming into operation of this Statute be calculated as follows:
 - (a) Years of service shall be reckoned from the date of appointment to the first of the consecutive pensionable positions held and seven years shall be added in the manner provided by Section 9 of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College Galway.
 - (b) The annual pension shall be a sum calculated by multiplying a sixtieth part of the stipend of the final consecutive pensionable position held by the number of years of service as calculated in (a) above.
2. For the purposes of this chapter, the position of full-time assistant shall be deemed to be a pensionable position in the case of holders of statutory positions in the College at the date of coming into operation of this statute.

CHAPTER IV

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made right acquired or act done under any previous Statute of the College.
2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-fifth day of November, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-nine, and may be cited as Statute LXXX of University College, Galway, or Stat. LXXX, Univ. Coll., Galway.
