STATUTE XLII.

We, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, Do by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XLII.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I.—NON-RECURRING PAYMENTS

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter I of Statute XXXVII the temporary increase of stipend hereinafter mentioned is hereby authorised to be paid to every person who held any one of the Statutory Offices, Professorships or Lectureships mentioned or referred to in Table "A" to the said Chapter during the whole or part of the year ended the 30th day of June, 1954, and the year ended the 30th day of June, 1955, that is to say, in respect of each of the said years, an

additional sum equal to £5 per cent. of the stipend actually paid or payable to him as the holder of such Statutory Office, Professorship or Lectureship.

#### CHAPTER II.—AMENDMENT OF STATUTE XXXVII.

1. Section 4 of Table "A" to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of all words from and including "shall be:—" where the same occur after "(t) Professorship of Celtic Archaeology" to the end of the first proviso in the said section contained and by the insertion in lieu thereof of the following:—

"shall be £1,200 on appointment increasing by £30 per annum to £1,500:

Provided that the holder of any of the foregoing full time Professorships to whom the terms of the first proviso heretofore in force and hereby deleted applied, shall, for the purpose of computing his stipend but without prejudice to the terms of the next proviso hereto, be deemed to have been appointed upon the 31st day of March, 1950".

2. Section 5 of Table "A" to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of all words from and including "shall be:—" where the same occur after "(m) Lectureship in Philosophy" to the words "15 years' service" in sub-section (ii), and by the insertion in lieu thereof of the following:—

"shall be £750 on appointment increasing by £50 per annum to £1,000, and increasing thereafter by £20 per annum for the following five years to £1,100:

Provided that the stipends of the holders of the foregoing Lectureships with increment additions shall be calculated accordingly, and the increased stipends so calculated shall be payable as from the date of coming into operation of this Statute."

#### CHAPTER III.

1. (a) Whenever and so often as it shall happen that a person shall be appointed a full time Professor or full time Lecturer in the College, who was not previously to his appointment either a full time Lecturer or a full time Assistant in the College, the President shall ascertain and report to the Governing Body in what Universities, University Colleges or other Institutions of University standing, and for what periods, such person has

held the appointment or discharged the functions of a Professor or Lecturer or Assistant and shall recommend to the Governing Body either—

- (i) that such person shall be paid upon appointment the annual stipend payable upon appointment provided by Statute XXXVII Chapter I in the case of a person appointed a full time Professor or a full time Lecturer as the case may be, without any increment or addition ; or
  - (ii) that such person should be deemed by virtue of his previous professional experience to have been a full time Professor or a full time Lecturer or a full time Assistant in the College. And if the President shall recommend the latter alternative he shall recommend also to the Governing Body the number of years of service which such person shall be deemed to have had as such full time Professor or full time Lecturer or full time Assistant as aforesaid.
- (b) The Governing Body shall thereupon consider the report of the President and his recommendation thereon and shall determine whether—

- (i) the stipend payable to such person shall be the stipend hereinbefore provided as payable upon appointment to a person having no previous service as a full time Professor or full time Lecturer or full time Assistant in the College ; or
- (ii) that such person shall be deemed upon appointment to have been a full time Professor or full time Lecturer or a full time Assistant in the College previously to his appointment. AND if the Governing Body shall determine upon the latter alternative they shall determine also the number of years of service which such person shall be deemed to have had as such full time Professor or full time Lecturer or full time Assistant in the College ; but it is hereby provided that the President may not recommend nor may the Governing Body determine that a person appointed to a full time Professorship has had years of service exceeding in the aggregate three years of actual service as a full time Professor, or that a person appointed to a full time Lectureship in the College has had years of service exceeding in the aggregate two years of actual service as a full time Lecturer.

## CHAPTER IV.—THE LECTURESHIP IN MATHEMATICS.

The holder of the Lectureship in Mathematics shall carry out the duties of the Lectureship subject to the direction of the Professor of Mathematics, and shall deliver lectures and instruction through Irish and through English in such a manner that the Professor of the subject with the Lecturers and Assistants (if any) assigned to him may in co-operation between them provide a complete course through the medium of Irish and a complete course through the medium of English.

## CHAPTER V.

1. This Statute shall come into operation on the Eighteenth day of October, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-five, and may be cited as Statute XLII of University College, Galway, or Stat. XLII Univ. Coll., Galway.
