STATUTE XLIV.

We, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts. Do by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XLIV.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the additions, modifications, and amendments hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I.

PROFESSORSHIP OF EXPERIMENTAL MEDICINE AND PRACTICAL PHARMACOLOGY.

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of its institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland a Full-time Professorship to be known as The Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology.

2. The annual Stipend of the Holder of the Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology shall be £1,450 on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £1,800 by annual increments of £70 for each completed year of service thereafter, subject to the provisions, where applicable, as to reckoning years of service set forth in Section 4 of Table "A" to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway, and as to added years set forth in Chapter III of Statute XLII of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER II.

LECTURESHIP IN ANATOMY AND LECTURESHIP IN PHYSIOLOGY.

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland two Full-time Lectureships as follows:—

- (i) A Lectureship in Anatomy—the Holder shall carry out the duties of this Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Anatomy;
- (ii) A Lectureship in Physiology—the Holder shall carry out the duties of this Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Physiology.

2. The Stipend of the Holder of each of the foregoing Lectureships shall be £900 per annum on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £1,320 per annum by annual increments of £60 for each completed year of service thereafter, subject to the provisions, where applicable, as to reckoning years of service set forth in Section 4 of Table "A" to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway, and as to added years set forth in Chapter III of Statute XLII of University College, Galway.

CHAPTER III.

PART-TIME LECTURESHIPS.

1. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland Part-time Lectureships as follows:—

- (i) A Lectureship in Pathology—the Holder shall carry out the duties of this Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Pathology;

- (ii) A Lectureship in Bacteriology—the Holder shall carry out the duties of this Lectureship under the direction of the Professor of Bacteriology ;
- (iii) A Lectureship in Paediatrics ;
- (iv) A Lectureship in Therapeutics.

2. The Stipend of the Holder of the Lectureship in Pathology and the Stipend of the Holder of the Lectureship in Bacteriology shall be £450 each per annum on appointment, increasing to a maximum of £660 each per annum by annual increments of £30 for each completed year of service thereafter.

3. The Stipend of the Holder of the Lectureship in Paediatrics and the Stipend of the Holder of the Lectureship in Therapeutics shall be £250 each per annum.

CHAPTER IV

LECTURESHIP IN MEDICAL JURISPRUDENCE AND LECTURESHIP IN PREVENTIVE MEDICINE.

1. The Part-time Lectureship in Medical Jurisprudence and Hygiene is hereby extinguished.

2. There shall be established in the College in the event of their institution by the Senate of the National University of Ireland two Part-time Lectureships to be known as (i) The Lectureship in Medical Jurisprudence, and (ii) The Lectureship in Preventive Medicine.

3. The Stipend of the Holder of the Lectureship in Medical Jurisprudence shall be £100 per annum, and the Stipend of the Holder of the Lectureship in Preventive Medicine shall be £250 per annum.

CHAPTER V.

PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES.

1. The Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology, The Lectureship in Anatomy, The Lectureship in Physiology, The Lectureship in Pathology, The Lectureship in Bacteriology, shall be pensionable Offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto, and shall be annexed to the appropriate Table of the Pensions Scheme. The Holders of the said Professorship and Lectureships shall be entitled to Pensions and Gratuities under and in accordance with the

provisions of Chapters II and III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway. There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for the purpose of providing pensions and gratuities for the said Offices. For the purpose of calculating pension and computing gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College, the annual Stipend in the case of the Holder of the Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology, and in the case of the Holders of the Lectureships in Anatomy, Physiology, Pathology, Bacteriology, shall be deemed to be the annual Stipend payable at the date of death or retirement of the Holder of the said Professorship or Lectureships, as the case may be, pursuant to the provisions of Chapters I, II, and III of this Statute.

CHAPTER VI.

1. The Holder of the Professorship of Experimental Medicine and Practical Pharmacology, and the Holders of the Lectureships in Pathology, Bacteriology, Paediatrics, Therapeutics, shall be required to give Clinical instruction to the Medical students of the College at such hours and in such Hospitals as the Academic Council may prescribe, subject to review by the Governing Body.

2. The duties of the Holders of the foregoing Lectureships, as regards amount and allocation of work, may be hereafter more fully defined by Regulations of the Governing Body.

CHAPTER VII.

1. Nothing hereinbefore contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred, or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-Seventh day of January, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight, and may be cited as Statute XLIV of University College, Galway, or Statute XLIV, Univ. Coll., Galway.
