STATUTE XLIX.

WE, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, Do by this present Instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XLIX

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I

THE PROFESSORSHIP OF NATURAL HISTORY

1. The Professorship of Natural History is hereby extinguished.
2. There shall be in the College (on such Professorships being instituted within the College by the Senate of The National University of Ireland) two full-time Professorships as follows:
  - (i) The Professorship of Botany;
  - (ii) The Professorship of Zoology.
3. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the foregoing two Professorships shall be £1,740 on appointment increasing to a maximum of £2,160 by annual increments of £84 for each completed year of service thereafter, subject to the provisions where applicable, as to reckoning years of service set forth in Section 4 of Table "A" to Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway, and subject to the provisions as to added years set forth in Chapter III of Statute XLII of University College, Galway.
4. The Professorship of Botany and the Professorship of Zoology shall be pensionable offices within the meaning of Chapter XXV of Statute XVII of University College, Galway, and the amendments thereto and shall be annexed to the appropriate table of the Pension Scheme. In each case, Pension and Gratuity shall be calculated and paid in accordance with the provisions of Chapter II

and III, of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway and the Statutes of the College. There shall be paid into the Pension Fund such additional sum as an Actuary shall certify to be necessary for providing such Pension and Gratuity as aforesaid. The annual stipend for the purpose of calculating Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College shall in each case be deemed to be that payable at the date of death or retirement of the holder pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of this Chapter.

5. The holder of the Professorship of Botany and the holder of the Professorship of Zoology shall each be entitled to the annual allowances in respect of wife and children payable pursuant to Section 6 of Chapter I of Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway.

## CHAPTER II

### THE LECTURESHIP IN MATHEMATICAL PHYSICS

The holder of the Lectureship in Mathematical Physics established by Statute XXXIII of University College, Galway, shall, notwithstanding anything contained in that Statute, henceforth carry out the duties of the Lectureship under the sole direction of the Professor of Mathematical Physics.

## CHAPTER III

### STATUTORY PENSIONABLE OFFICERS PENSION FUND

Instead of the sum of £9,805 now being paid annually into the Pension Fund (now designated Statutory Pensionable Officers' Pension Fund) there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the said Fund out of the annual income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other moneys of the College applicable thereto an annual sum of £10,955.

## CHAPTER IV

### THE WIDOWS OF STATUTORY PENSIONABLE OFFICERS' PENSION FUND

Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 2 of Chapter I of Statute XL of University College, Galway, the Governing Body shall pay into 'The Widows of Statutory Pensionable Officers' Pension Fund' on the coming into operation of this Statute a sum of £500 and annually on every first day of January thereafter a further sum of £500 until the Governing Body shall otherwise determine.

## CHAPTER V

### PRESIDENT'S EMOLUMENTS

As and from the first day of July, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-one and pending the provision of an official residence, the President shall have as part of his emoluments (instead of and as the equivalent of the pensionable allowance of £360 per annum to which he is entitled by virtue of Section 3 of Chapter I of Statute XLVII of University College, Galway) residence, fuel and light within the College in such apartments as have been designated by decision of the Governing Body.

CHAPTER VI

1. Nothing herein contained shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

2. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of May, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-one and may be cited as Statute XLIX of University College, Galway or Stat. XLIX Univ. Coll., Galway.
