STATUTE XXXVII.

We, the Governing Body of University College, Galway, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on us by the above Acts, Do by this present instrument under the Seal of University College, Galway, make the Statute contained in the Schedule hereto for the general government of the said College.

SCHEDULE—STATUTE XXXVII.

All previous Statutes of University College, Galway, shall be read and construed with the alterations, additions and modifications hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER I.—STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES ATTACHED TO STATUTORY OFFICES, PROFESSORSHIPS AND LECTURESHIPS.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of University College, Galway, the stipends and allowances attached to the Statutory Offices, Professorships and Lectureships mentioned or referred to in Table "A" to this Chapter on and from the first day of April, 1950, shall be the stipends and allowances set forth in the said Table.

2. This Chapter shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st day of March, 1950.

TABLE "A."

1. The stipend of the President shall be £1,900 per annum, and, in addition he shall be entitled to residence, fuel and light as heretofore, and to an allowance of £200 per annum in respect of the expenses of his office.

2. The stipend of the Registrar and Secretary shall be £450 per annum.

3. The stipend of the Bursar shall be £150 per annum.

4. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time Professorships, namely :—

- (a) Professorship of Modern Irish ;
- (b) Professorship of Old and Middle Irish and Celtic Philology ;
- (c) Professorship of Ancient Classics ;
- (d) Professorship of Mathematics ;
- (e) Professorship of Experimental Physics ;
- (f) Professorship of English Language and English Literature ;
- (g) Professorship of Chemistry ;
- (h) Professorship of Natural History ;
- (i) Professorship of Civil Engineering ;
- (j) Professorship of Anatomy ;
- (k) Professorship of Physiology ;
- (l) Professorship of Mathematical Physics ;
- (m) Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy ;
- (n) Professorship of Romance Languages ;
- (o) Professorship of German ;
- (p) Professorship of History ;
- (q) Professorship of Philosophy ;
- (r) Professorship of Economics, Commerce and Accountancy ;
- (s) Professorship of Education ;
- (t) Professorship of Celtic Archaeology ;

shall be :—

- (i) £1,200 on appointment ;
- (ii) £1,300 on completion of 10 years' service ;
- (iii) £1,400 on completion of 15 years' service ;
- (iv) £1,500 on completion of 20 years' service ;

Provided that the annual stipend of the present holder of any of the foregoing full-time Professorships whose present annual stipend is less than £1,200, shall be :—

- (i) £1,200 ;
- (ii) £1,300 on completion of 10 years' service ;
- (iii) £1,400 on completion of 15 years' service ;
- (iv) £1,500 on completion of 20 years' service ;

Provided also that in the case of the holder of any of the foregoing full-time Professorships, who, previous to his appointment as a full-time Professor, was a full-time Lecturer in the College or a full-time Assistant in the College, his years of service for the purposes of the foregoing scales of stipends shall be reckoned as follows, namely, (a) his actual number of years of service as such full-time Professor, and in addition (b) two-thirds of his actual number of years of service (if any) as a full-time Lecturer in the College, and in addition (c) one-half of his actual number of years of service (if any) as a full-time Assistant in the College; and the holder of each of the foregoing full-time Professorships shall be entitled to the annual stipend set out in the foregoing scales of stipends appropriate to his total number of completed years of service (including service before as well as subsequent to the coming into operation of this paragraph) reckoned as aforesaid.

5. The annual stipend of the holder of each of the following full-time Lectureships, namely,

- (a) Lectureship in Mathematics (through Irish);
- (b) Lectureship in Education (through Irish);
- (c) Lectureship in History (through Irish);
- (d) Lectureship in Ancient Classics (through Irish);
- (e) Lectureship in Economics, Commerce and Accountancy (through Irish);
- (f) Lectureship in Civil Engineering ;
- (g) Lectureship in Botany ;
- (h) Lectureship in Experimental Physics ;
- (i) Lectureship in Mathematical Physics ;
- (j) Lectureship in Chemistry ;
- (k) Lectureship in Romance Languages ;
- (l) Lectureship in Celtic Languages ;
- (m) Lectureship in Philosophy ;

shall be :—

- (i) £750 on appointment increasing by £50 per annum to £1,000 ;
- (ii) £1,100 after completion of 15 years' service ;

Provided that in the case of the holder of any of the foregoing full-time Lectureships, who previous to his appointment as a full-time Lecturer was a full-time Assistant in the College, his years of service for the purposes of the foregoing scale of stipends shall be reckoned as follows, namely, (a) his actual number of years of service as such full-time Lecturer, and, in addition, (b) two-thirds of his actual number of years of service as a full-time Assistant in the College; and the holder of each of the foregoing full-time Lectureships shall be entitled to the annual stipend set out in the foregoing scale of stipends appropriate to his total number of completed years of service (including service before as well as subsequent to the coming into operation of this paragraph) reckoned as aforesaid.

6. Each full-time Statutory Officer of the College, and each full-time Professor and each full-time Lecturer who is a married man shall be entitled to an annual allowance of £40 in respect of his wife and an annual allowance of £30 in respect of each child under the age of 18 years, and each full-time Statutory Officer of the College and each full-time Professor and each full-time Lecturer who is a widower or a widow shall be entitled to an annual allowance of £30 in respect of each child under the age of 18 years.

CHAPTER II.—PENSION FUND.

1. In lieu of the sum of £4,410 now being paid annually into the Pension Fund pursuant to Section I of Chapter I of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, there shall henceforth be paid and transferred to the Pension Fund out of the annual income granted by the Oireachtas for the general purposes of the College or out of any other moneys of the College applicable thereto the following sums at the times hereinafter specified, namely,

- (i) on or before the 31st July, 1951, the sum of £5,500 together with an additional sum of £1,100;
- (ii) on or before the 31st July in each succeeding year thereafter the sum of £5,500.

CHAPTER III.—PENSIONS.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the pension of each full-time Statutory Officer, each full-time Professor and each full-time Lecturer of the College, save as is hereinafter provided, shall be calculated in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College, on the annual stipend payable at the date of retirement to such full-time Statutory Officer, full-time Professor or full-time Lecturer of the College pursuant to the provisions of Chapter I of this Statute,

Provided that for the purposes of calculating the amount of pension payable on the retirement of (a) the President, (b) the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, (c) the present holder of the Professorship of Education, and (d) the Lady Superintendent, the annual stipend payable at the date of retirement shall be deemed to be

- (a) in the case of the President, £2,200 ;
- (b) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £1,950 ;
- (c) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £1,650 ;
- (d) in the case of the Lady Superintendent, £500.

2. Section 2 of Chapter II of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, is hereby revoked.

CHAPTER IV.—GRATUITIES.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Statute of the College the annual stipend of each full-time Statutory Officer, each full-time Professor, and each full-time Lecturer of the College for the purposes of calculating in accordance with the relevant provisions of existing Statutes of the College, the amount of the gratuity payable on the death or retirement of such full-time Statutory Officer, full-time Professor, or full-time Lecturer, save as is hereinafter provided, shall be the annual stipend payable at the date of death or retirement to such full-time Statutory Officer, full-time Professor, or full-time Lecturer, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter I of this Statute,

Provided that for the purposes of calculating the amount of the gratuity payable on the death or retirement of (a) the President, (b) the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical, Geography and Mineralogy, (c) the present holder of the Professorship of Education, and (d) the Lady Superintendent, the annual stipend payable at the date of death or retirement shall be deemed to be

- (a) in the case of the President, £2,200 ;
- (b) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Geology including Physical Geography and Mineralogy, £1,950 ;
- (c) in the case of the present holder of the Professorship of Education, £1,650 ;
- (d) in the case of the Lady Superintendent, £500.

2. Section 3 of Chapter III of Statute XXXVI of University College, Galway, is hereby revoked.

CHAPTER V.

1. For the purposes of this Statute

- (a) the full-time Statutory Officers of the College are the President and the Lady Superintendent ;
- (b) the full-time Professors of the College are the holders of the Professorships set forth in paragraph 4 of Table " A " to Chapter I of this Statute ;
- (c) the full-time Lecturers of the College are the holders of the Lectureships set forth in paragraph 5 of Table " A " to Chapter I of this Statute.

2. Nothing contained in this Statute shall affect any appointment made, right acquired, liability incurred or act done under any previous Statute of the College.

CHAPTER VI.

1. This Statute shall come into operation on the Twenty-ninth day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-one, and may be cited as Statute XXXVII of University College, Galway, or Stat. XXXVII Univ. Coll., Galway.
