



Membership of the Academic Promotions Committee, 2026 (Spring)

Membership is normally for three years. *Ex officio* members will serve while in office. All other members serve normally for three years, with one-third of the membership scheduled to rotate each year. This is to ensure continuity in the work through rolling changes in membership. Such membership is renewable once only (except those among the first membership who agreed to serve a four-year term). External nominees are for two years and are nominated by the President following consultation with the academic trade unions.
