Important Notice for Past Students Returning to the University of Galway via CAO or the Postgraduate Application System re: your old ID

number



It is the University of Galway's policy to retain your full student history under your *first or old University ID Number* therefore you **SHOULD NOT** register under your newly assigned CAO or Postgrad Application number.



If you did not specify in your application that you are a past student you must now contact Admissions to get your ID numbers merged:

For undergraduate (CAO):

For postgraduate:

<u>postgradadmissions@nuigalway.ie</u> (taught courses) <u>pgresearch@nuigalway.ie</u> (research courses)



What are the implications if your numbers are not merged before you start your course?

It will affect:

- Your fees record
- You may lose NUI Galway emails post merge
- You will lose everything you have on Blackboard e.g. assignments, notes, results, blogs etc post merge
- You will need a new ID card
- No access to the Library
- It will cause confusion on course classlists, SU card, Socs and club etc
