



University of Galway offer terms and conditions

- To secure a place on a course, applicants must accept the offer and pay a non-refundable deposit* by the offer expiry date, as specified on the online offer page;
- In exceptional cases, a deposit extension may be applied for by contacting the Admissions Office, detailing the circumstances which necessitate the extension.
- Acceptance of this offer will not prejudice consideration of applications to other postgraduate/undergraduate (non-EU) programmes at University of Galway. However, at any given stage you can only have one valid acceptance for University of Galway. Acceptance of a more recent offer will supersede all previous acceptances;
- The University reserves the right to withdraw an offer or amend course offerings at any time
- An applicant's deposit, paid upon an earlier acceptance, may be transferred to another University of Galway programme, onto which that applicant has subsequently been accepted. This rule does not apply to the Professional Masters in Education i.e. deposits may neither be transferred to nor from the PME/MGO
- Under EU directive, applicants are entitled to a refund if requested within 14 days of payment. The deposit is non-refundable after the cooling off period of 14-days.
- The deposit may not be transferred to other applicants or registered students on other University of Galway programmes
- The deposit will be netted-off against the total fee liability upon registration;
- The deposit will be transferred to University of Galway programmes for the subsequent year in the case where an applicant has been approved to defer their place. This rule does not apply to the Professional Master of Education;
- The deposit may be transferred to University of Galway programmes for the subsequent year on medical grounds only and where the applicant has made a request to the Admissions Office along with supporting certificates. This rule does not apply to the Professional Master of Education;
- The deposit is refundable upon an applicant not meeting the requirements of a conditional offer;
- The offer (conditional or otherwise) is subject to the applicant satisfying the minimum entry requirements of the programme;
- The offer (conditional or otherwise) is subject to the applicant satisfactorily completing all Garda Vetting requirements, where applicable;
- University of Galway reserves the right to cancel a programme of study in any given year on the basis of insufficient registrants or due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All applicants must ensure they have all required funding for study in Ireland prior to the acceptance of any offer; deposits will not be returned in the event that an applicant is unable to attend due to a lack of funding.
- Deposit refunds can be issued only in the event that evidence of a declined visa application can be provided.
