The ceremony today, which involves a procession led by a mace bearer, musical accompaniment, the special robes, and the use of English and Irish, has a long tradition spanning many centuries. In Ireland it goes all the way back to the first university, established in Dublin in 1320, though it no longer exists, and has continued through the establishment and continuation of ten further universities. This University was originally one of three Queen's Colleges established in 1845 in Belfast, Cork and Galway.

Then as now this University and its staff have been about ensuring that those who pass through here as students go out into the wide world equipped with the best education that they can get and that we can give them. The word 'university' comes from the Latin 'universitas magistrorum et scholarium'
