Lá mór i bhféilire na hOllscoile atá ann agus ócáid níos mó agus níos tábhachtaí arís in bhur saol féin. Go maire sibh bhur gcéimíocht úr agus guím gach rath oraibh sa tsaol atá romhaibh amach mar chéimithe de chuid Ollscoil na hÉireann, Gaillimh.

The formal ceremony today, which involves a procession led by a mace bearer, musical accompaniment, the special robes, and the use of Latin, English and Irish, has a long tradition spanning many centuries. In Ireland it goes all the way back to the first university, established in Dublin in 1320, though it no longer exists, and has continued through the establishment and continuation of ten further universities. This University was originally one of three Queen's Colleges established in 1845 in Belfast, Cork and Galway.

Then as now this University and its staff have been about ensuring that those who pass through here as students go out into the wide world equipped with the best education that they can get and that we can give them. The word 'university' comes from the Latin

Having completed her Midwifery training in the Coombe Hospital, she worked in Dublin as a Staff Nurse before travelling to work in Paris. Following several years working in Paris she returned to work in the Meath Hospital in Dublin.

Jean held a number of Senior Nurse Management roles in Galway University Hospitals before being appointed as Director of Nursing in 2013.

Jean was appointed to the position of Chief Director of Nursing & Midwifery for the Saolta University Healthcare Group in November 2014. She played a central role in the consolidation and development of the Hospital Group.

Jean has worked throughout her career to promote and develop nursing. One of her major achievements has been the development of the Advanced Nurse Practitioner programme. She has worked closely with NUI Galway to ensure that the undergraduate and post graduate programmes meet the demands of the service. She has worked closely with the School of Nursing and Midwifery to promote relevant research in the profession.

She recognises the contribution that nursing can make to healthcare and the opportunities for nurses to practise using their full experience and training

Jean has always valued the unique role that nurses play in the patient's experience of healthcare. She was the lead for patient engagement in the Saolta Hospital Group and the Group has been recognised nationally for its excellence in this area.

Since retiring in 2020, Jean has managed the Galway Vaccination Centre and sits on the Boards of both the Galway Hospice Foundation and Cancer Care West.

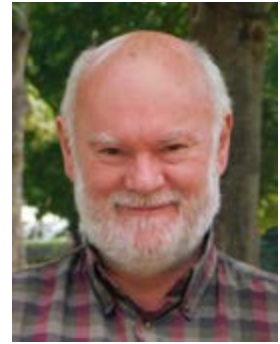

David Harper

David Harper is a leading international expert on palaeontology and the fossil record. He is Emeritus Professor of Palaeontology and former Principal of Van Mildert College in Durham University, and Chair of the International Commission for Stratigraphy – an extensive global network of leading experts tasked with reconstructing the history of the Earth. He is a former President of the International Palaeontological Association and the Palaeontological Association.



David began his teaching career in University College Galway before moving to a professorship in Copenhagen in 1998. He has published over 15 books and monographs, including several influential textbooks, such as the recent second edition of *Introduction to Paleobiology and the Fossil Record* (with Michael J. Benton). Professor Harper has published over 350 scientific articles (with almost 40,000 citations) and, together with Øyvind Hammer and Paul Ryan, the widely-used software package PAST.

More recently, his research has addressed some of the most fundamentally important developments in the history of life, for example the Cambrian Explosion, Great Ordovician Biodiversification Event and the End Ordovician mass extinction. These events occurred over 440 million years ago, yet their impact had profound consequences for the evolution of the modern marine realm. These research programmes address ocean ecosystems and past climate change, taking David to many parts of the world including Australia, Chile, China, Greenland, Russia, Scandinavia and Tibet. His research has been recognised by foreign memberships of the Royal Danish Academy of Sciences and Letters, the Royal Swedish Physiographic Society and an Einstein Professorship in the Chinese Academy of Sciences.
