## **HEALTH INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

All international students must be enrolled in the Canisius College health insurance plan, purchased through Allen J. Flood. Students will be enrolled in the plan by the office of International Student Programs. **Exceptions for alternative insurance will not be made.**

### FALL 2023 INTERNATIONAL NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION \*\*

- **All students must arrive to campus by Sunday, August 20, 2023**
- Mandatory International New Student Orientation - - August 21 – 23, 2023
- Mandatory Orientation for ALL new students - - August 24 – 27, 2022
- Classes begin on Monday, August 28, 2023
- Last day of final exams - - December 15, 2023

### SPRING 2024 INTERNATIONAL NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION \*\*

- **All students must arrive to campus by Thursday, January 11, 2024**
- Mandatory International New Student Orientation - - January 12, 2024
- Mandatory Orientation for ALL new students - - January 13, 2024
- Classes begin on Tuesday, January 16, 2024
- Last day of final exams - - May 10, 2024

**\*\* These dates are subject to change.**

If you have any exams that you need to take for your home university that conflict with your required arrival date and orientation at Canisius College, it is critical that you contact your faculty members and make arrangements to take those exams before you arrive at Canisius. If that is not possible, we can make arrangements to proctor your exams at Canisius after you have arrived. Please let us know of these required arrangements ahead of time, so that we may properly plan to have the exams proctored.

Review course selections for your desired semester and make a list of preferred courses prior to arrival. Student will meet with their academic advisor during orientation for class registration.
