#### College Fees

The following fees are payable by both BBS and BComm students:

Student Levy	A student levy is payable by all students at the beginning of each of the first four years of the degree studies. In 2021/2022 the student levy was €140
Meal Charge	Year 1 students are provided with lunch in the college on Wednesday and Thursday during the 10 weeks of practical training (total of 20 meals). Each lunch is a three course meal. In 2020/2021 the meal charge was €250.

#### Salaries

The salaries identified above are for guideline purposes only. The Year 2 salary is on average €19,500. Some contracts may include meals and/or lodging and many students benefit from a hotel service charge or tips. The salaries in the final year placement can vary greatly according to the country, the Hotel Company, position etc. The highest salary in 2020/2021 is \$47,500 (approx. €39,800) and a small number of student's secured contracts with this salary. For an average student, a sample salary in Ireland is €24,000, a sample salary in the Middle East is AED 18,000 (and can include accommodation, transport, meals, medical, uniforms and laundry). These sample salaries are annual salaries and in some cases they increase after the first 9 months (upon graduation) pending contracts. Students enrolling in September 2022 will begin their final year placement in 2026, by which time salaries and contracts will have changed from the figures outlined above.

## Other Costs

Costs	Approx. Amount	Details
Accommodation	€4,320	The college's provider of student accommodation is Castlegardens, Bunratty Village. The cost of accommodation is €4320 (36 weeks x €120) plus a security deposit of €250. (please note the number of weeks may change)
Utilities Deposit	€500	A utilities deposit of approx. €500 is payable and will be offset against the utility bills.
Bus	€400	The college organises a bus to transfer students from Bunratty to the college each morning. Students have the option to buy a monthly (€60) per semester (€200) per semester or yearly (€400) ticket.
Uniforms	€740	Includes college business suit, restaurant uniform, chef uniform, kitchen knives and kitchen safety shoes.
Books	€250	Students will have to buy mandatory books for Year 1. Students may be able to buy these books second hand which would help to reduce the cost.
Health Insurance		Health insurance is mandatory for visa purposes. The cost will differ depending on the type of health insurance you choose to purchase.
