

# International Foundation Business Programme 2022

The International Foundation Business Programme caters specifically for the academic and/or English needs of students who are not academically ready to directly enter undergraduate degree programmes at Shannon College of Hotel Management and/or the Business School at NUI Galway. It is ideally suited to students who have not attained the academic and/or English requirements for their chosen degree. This programme will include the following modules; English for Business, English for Life, Academic English, Management, Personal Developments, Mathematics, Intercultural Communications, Economics and Accounting.

## Books/Materials

Students will be provided with mandatory text books, at an approximate cost of €250.

## Uniform

Students wear a uniform to class each day. The uniforms will be provided by the college uniform supplier upon registration, costing approximately €150. The uniform consists of a pair of black trousers, a black jumper, two white shirts, a college tie/scarf and name badges. The uniform is compulsory.

## Health Insurance

## Accommodation

The College's provider of student accommodation is located at Castle Gardens, Bunnratty Village. The cost of the accommodation for 2021/2022 was €4,200 (35 weeks x €120, please note number of weeks may change) plus a security deposit of €250. There is also a utilities charge of €500 and this will be offset against the utility bills.
