Import your Pubmed Publications by Keyword or by PMID to IRIS

You can search pubmed by keyword or by PMID through IRIS and when the records have been retrieved you will be prompted to accept or reject the publications for your IRIS profile.

Step 1 Publications Import/Export

Select **'Outputs'** from the IRIS horizontal menu bar and then select **'Add Publications'** from the vertical menu bar. Select **"Search Online Sources"** at the bottom of the screen screen.
