Environmental Science is an **interdisciplinary study** which examines interaction between humans and the environment, with specific reference to the effects of modern technological advances on the environment.



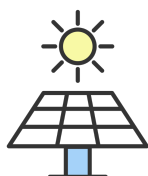
Opportunities also exist in the **private sector**, as well as working as **researchers**.
